Directions

Grid Ref. SH 9024 3237

At the traffic lights on the A5 at the other side of Corwen, turn left for BALA on the A494. As you enter Bala turn left onto the B4391 sp. Llangunog. Follow this along the head of the lake, just over 1/2 mile. Turn right at the old bridge. Bala light railway now on left, on B4403. Follow this for app 2 miles. Opposite a road junction to the left is a track to the right. A galvanised shed is the clue. Take the track on the **right**, over the railway line, bear left through a gate, when you get to the Sailing club area.

THE CLUB PROVIDES some charcoal and metal frying grills, but bring your own if you have one.

Bring as much clean wood as you can for the campfire (No pallets this year as they burn too quickly and damage the tree canopy)

Bring a boat or canoe if you have one.

Bring your own drinks and some BBQ. food (There are no pubs in walking distance).

**The sparks from the campfire will improve the breathability of your Gore-Tex and fleece. It will do nothing for the waterproofness. You have been warned! Wear your old gear.**
