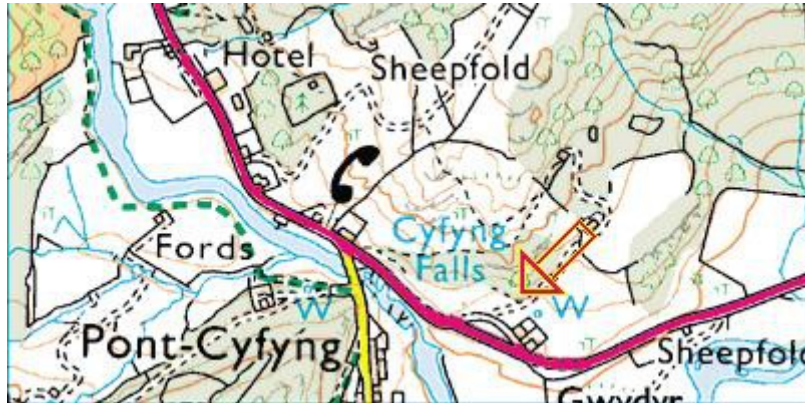




Haggis meet Friday January 25th – Sunday January 27th 2019.

Parking is in the small car park by the Bryn Glo Cafe. Do not park in front of the gate. It is advisable not to leave any gear or valuables in your vehicle. Access to the barn is via the stile next to the gate and then 5 minutes up the track, **a torch will be needed at night.**



There are **18 spaces** for this trip so book early via the Club Bulletin board and facebook page It has the usual cooking facilities and sleeping area. Bring a warm sleeping bag. There is a wood burning stove in the main room. This only burns timber, no coal, so bring a few logs if you have some.

Cost is the bargain price of £7 per person per night. plus the cost of the haggis dinner .Sorry no dogs allowed in the hut..

Food is available at the Tyn-y-Coed hotel which is only 200m up the road. We will be there on the Friday night.

On the Saturday night we will be cooking a communal haggis dinner for Burns Night. The cost should be only a few pounds each. Left or right handed haggis and even vegetarian ones are available.

What to do
