Torver centre Grid Ref 284 942. Church House Post Code LA21 8AY

Torver is SW of Coniston. Either travel up to Kendal, Windermere, and Ambleside to then head south to Coniston OR Join the A590 after leaving the M6 to Grenodd then the A5092 to Lowick Green then onto A5084 to Torver.
 To approach the Car park, for the hut, take the turning on a sharp bend North of the village. Follow the track, around a sharp right hand bend, passed white cottages, then the road narrows, keep going, to a gate. Through the gate and the parking is on the left.

Walking on Coniston Horseshoe, or climbing on Dow Crag.

Tranearth is a well appointed hut, light, electricity, log burning fire, plenty of cooking facilities, 1 large dorm and a number of smaller rooms. The Challenge with this hut is that you are required to walk, for about a kilometre, from where you park the car. This requires planning and organisation as all of your supplies will also need to be carried in. You will also need a good torch. The rough farm track to the car park area is tight and pitted so drive carefully.

Torver is blessed with two pubs, or it was the last time that we visited. On Friday night, sustenance will be taken in the Church House . There are no shops in the village, bring all of your own food and beer and wine
