CENTRE GATES – please keep the centre gates closed at all times. Campers and Caravanners who have booked into Bwlchgwyn Camping Site which adjoins the centre, regularly accidentally park in the centre car park when booking into Bwlchgwyn Reception. This will prevent other potential campers joining you, and any problems with unauthorised cars being locked in.



CAMP AREA - will be on the main field on the embankment and flat area adjoining a new vertical and sloping wooden wall used for team tasks. Best access will be from top of the car park next to trailers.

CAR PARKING – the field can get muddy and vehicles have been known to get stuck. Therefore, if ground conditions are dry you can off load equipment from vehicles at the campsite, but vehicles must then be parked in the main car parking.

SHOWER BLOCK & TOILETS – access is through the main entrance double doors into the centre. The hot water is heated by an emersion heater so may need time to refill and heat up. Cleaning supplies will be left available, so please ensure that the showers are cleaned down after use. Further information will be provided.

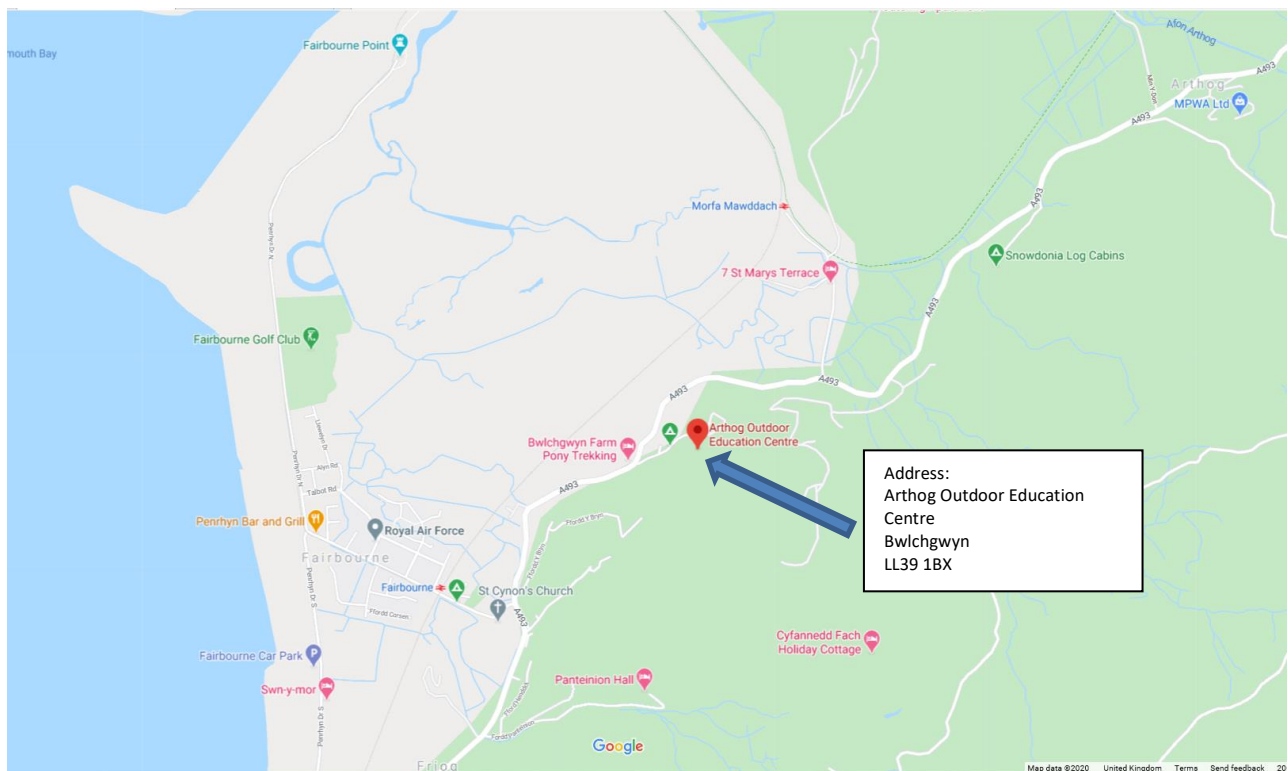
DRYING ROOMS – there are 2x drying rooms, located next to each shower block. The dehumidifiers are switched on/off by plug on the wall. Please ensure they are switched off after use, and before departing on Monday.

RUBBISH – General rubbish can be put into the bins in the bin compound near the main entrance. Covid 19 related PPE (face masks, gloves etc.) will need to be taken home.

FIRE PIT – a fire pit has been left in the stone circle at the top of the main field. Please bring some wood with you.
